

OneVA Enterprise Architecture April 2014 Release

Washington, D.C., April 2014 – On April 1, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Office of Architecture, Strategy, and Design published the OneVA Enterprise Architecture (OneVA EA) April 2014 Release.

The OneVA EA is a comprehensive picture of VA's operations, capabilities, and services, and the business and IT capabilities that serve them. This architecture is an evolving entity built through ongoing collaboration between each Administration's business and technology leaders, staff, and stakeholders. As the Department's vision, mission, and goals evolve over time, the OneVA EA will change to meet those needs.

The OneVA EA April 2014 Release includes interactive visual enhancements to the OneVA EA intranet website. For example, architecture models are presented via a web browser that allows a user to zoom in and out of the models and easily drag and move a model with their mouse or touch pad. Additionally, when a user selects an element depicted in the model, relevant information is displayed alongside, allowing the user to drill down into OneVA EA data using the model itself. These new enhancements increase the overall accessibility and usability of the content contained within the OneVA EA. In addition, this release offers new and updated architecture content and EA governance documents that bring standardization to the architecture development process.
