

Major Initiative (MI) 1:

The Five Year Plan to End Homelessness among Veterans will assist every eligible homeless Veteran to acquire safe housing; needed treatment services; opportunities to return to employment; and benefits assistance. Based on a philosophy of no wrong door, the Plan assists eligible Veterans whether they seek help from a VA Medical Center, a Regional Office, or a Community Organization. Services include an expansion of existing program capacity and treatment services, as well as the implementation of new programs focused on homelessness prevention and increased access to permanent housing with supportive services.

Description: This is a view of the systems, services, and organizations that support MI 1 in the context of eliminating Veteran homelessness. The primary systems and services with respect to the scope of MI 1 are internal systems, all other non-VA agencies, systems and services are considered external.
