2.13 - Provide Organizational Leadership and Administrative Support; 2.14 - Provide Legal Guidance and Representation;  
2.15 - Coordinate National Security Operations; 2.16 - Manage Physical and Personnel Security

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
2.13 - Provide Organizational Leadership and Administrative Support consists of the internal leadership oversight and incidental back-office functions that each office performs in addition to that organization's primary mission

2.14 - Provide Legal Guidance and Representation involves providing legal advice concerning, and defending the administration of, VA operations and programs. This includes determining whether current or proposed VA operations and programs are consistent with laws, regulations, court decisions, Administration policy, and VA policy. It also includes providing legal representation to defend challenges to VA's administration of those programs

2.15 - Coordinate National Continuity of Operations involves coordinating the Department's programs to ensure essential functions continue to be performed during a catastrophic event and normal operations resume after a catastrophic event. This includes all aspects of planning and preparing for an event, maintaining essential operations during an event, managing response to an event, and recovering in the wake of an event.

2.16 - Manage Physical and Personnel Security involves the physical protection of an organization's personnel, assets, and facilities (including security clearance management). Note: Activities related to securing data and information systems are addressed under the Information Systems Security Service
